MINUTES BEAVER COUNCIL JANURARY 4, 1982

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAVER ARKANSAS MET AT 7:30 P M AT THE HOME OF ALDERMAN BALDRIDGE FOR THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING.

THE MAYOR CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER. PRESENT: ALDERMAN BALDRIDGE, REITZ, STEWART, RUTTER, DURLAND CLERK FITZSIMMONS AND MAYOR THOMAS.

THE MINUTES WERE READ FROM THE DECEMBER 1981 MEETING AND WITH NO CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS THEY STOOD AS READ.

MAYOR THOMAS READ A LETTER FROM SENATOR BUMPER TO S C OF STATE PAUL RIVIERE AND MR RIVIERES ANSWER TO SAID LETTER. REFERENS TO B AVER CENSUS. THE BEAVER CENSUS STANDS OFFICIALLY AT 82 ALTHOUGH THIS FIGURE HAS NOT BEEN CERTIFIED , ACCORDING TO THE SEC OF STATE.

MAYOR THOMAS READ A COPY OF THE LETTER HE WROTE TO THE RESIDENT ENGINEER MR GROVES, REGARDING THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR THE PARK LEASE AND PROJECTED BUDGET SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

MAYOR THOMAS SUGGESTED THE COUNCIL SUPPORT AN AD HOC PARK COMMITTEE THAT HE WOOULD APPOINT WITH COUNCILS APPROVAL AND READ A MEMO HE PREPARED WITH THE COMMITTEES PROPOSED PURPOSE.

THE QUESTION OF POWER OF THE COMMITTEE WAS ASKED BY ALDERMAN BALDRIDGE, THE MAYOR REPLYED THAT THE POWER OG THE COMMITTEE WOULD BE FULL POWER TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE PARK, BUT ALL MONIES WOULD BE TURNED IN TO AND DISPURSED BY, THE TOWN TREASURE.

THE MAYOR SUGGESTED THAT ALL SUGGESTIONS FROM ALL PEOPLES BE OPENLY DISCUSSED BY THE COMMITTEE WITH THE COUNCIL AND IF THERE ARE ANY COMPLAINTS, THE COMPLAINTANT BY ASKED TO PUT HIS COMPLAINT IN WRITTING AND BRING IT TO THE COUNCIL.

THE PARK COMMITTEE WILL ALSO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ADVERTISEMENTS.

ALONG WITH THE OPENING OF THE BEAVER TOWN PARK.


A LETTER FROM THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS STATED THE OFFICIAL COUNT OF BEAVER TO BE 82.





DEWEY FRENCH, MARY ELLEN PETERSON, ROBERT MARTY, AND VIOLA COMER.





With no further business Alderman Baldrige made motion for adjournment and Alderman Reitz 2nd. Vote unanimous.


