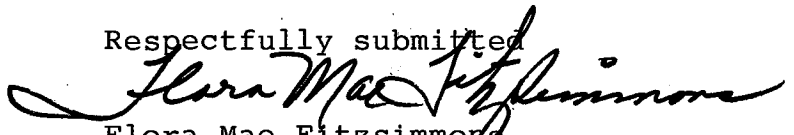
A discussion of Funds supporting the Beaver Fire Dept was discussed and it was decided that nothing be changed unless the problem surfaced again.

The Council of the Incorporated Town of Beaver, Arkansas met march 2, 1991 for the regular monthly meeting. Mayor Ratliff called the meeting to order at 2 P.M. The following aldermen answered roll call: Alderman Fuller, Rutter, Baldrige, Thomas and Bengé. Quorum present.

A letter was read from the Corp of Engr. RE: Thank you and approval of the park chairman management plan for 1991.

A letter from Phil Dickson was read RE: permission from the town council to use the Beaver Park Boat Ramp to launch an Amphibious Ducks sightseeing tour. Mr. Dickson was PRESENT and after much discussion between MR. DICKSON and the COUNCIL - Alderman Thomas suggested council grant permission for the launching during the 1991 season only, and made MOTION the town of Beaver grant Mr. Dickson permission, to launch only, from the Beaver Park Boat Ramp for the 1991 season, pending future park use conditions and agreement as fee for permit. During added discussion Alderman Thomas suggested letting Mr. Dickson work on a gentlemen's agreement until details can be worked out. Alderman Baldrige suggested turning the matter over to the park committee and they report their comments to the council. All agreed to leave conditions and permit fees to the park committee.

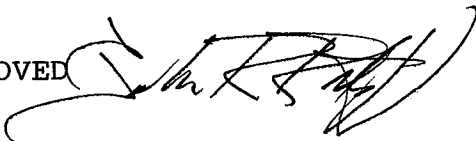

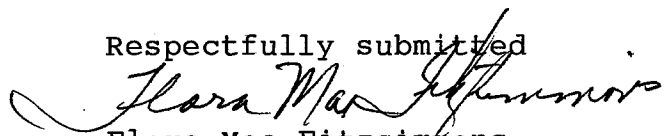

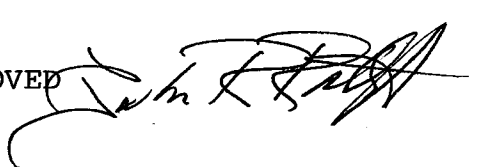
The Post office has been built to Federal standards for the handicapped and No Smoking will include the many resortorally handicapped who pay for P O box and are entitled to be able to use this service.

Alderman Thomas withdrew his motion for no smoking at this time and all present agreed.

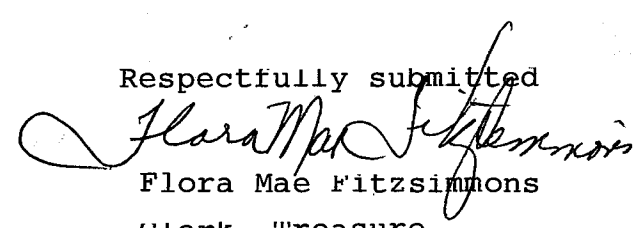
Mayor Ratliff called ^{upon} Marshall Michalowski to swear in Deputy Marshall Greg King. So done.

Mayor Ratliff has sent complete report of Building and Zoning Permit System.

Report from Representative Hammerschmidt regarding mowing restrictions adjacent to Corps property was discussed.

The Adopt a Highway sign at the West end of the bridge was discussed. The Mayor read letter he wrote to the Highway Dept., requesting that they move the sign to the east end of the bridge, so that it would not be in possible violation of the town's sign ordinance.

Letter to Phil Dickson of Duck Tours was read, wherein the Mayor reminded him that his request to launch at the Beaver Park had been denied. Mayor Ratliff will attend the meeting next Tuesday, September 9 in Eureka Springs.

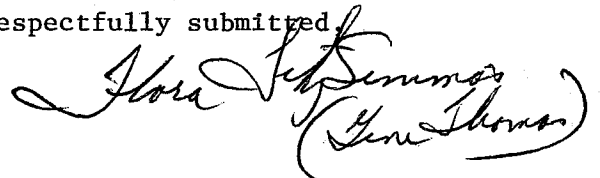
