Minutes

Town of Beaver Council Meeting

July 8, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Brian Weinmann was sworn in as Alderman.

Present were Mayor Shoffit, Alderwoman Lester, Alderman Baldridge, Alderman Goodman, Alderwoman Going and Alderman Weinmann.

The minutes from May 13, 2019 were presented. Alderman Baldridge moved to accept minutes, seconded by Alderwoman Lester. The minutes were approved on a voice vote.

The financial statements for May and June 2019 were presented. After review Alderman Baldridge moved to accept the financial statements for May as presented, seconded by Alderman Weinmann. The May financial statements were approved on a voice vote. After review Alderwoman Lester moved to accept the financial statements for June as presented, seconded by Alderman Weinmann. The June financial statements were approved on a voice vote.

Under Old Business Mayor Shoffit reported that she had faxed all the information to John Wilkerson at the Municipal League to help deal with the CUP situation. Changes did need to be made to CUP code regarding length of time for rentals.

Alderwoman Going moved to accept Resolution 2019-2 to Chapter V Article 5-4, seconded by Alderwoman Lester. Resolution was approved on a voice vote.

Recorder Adams read Ordinance 2019-02 for the second time. Alderwoman Going moved to accept second reading of Ordinance 2019-02, seconded by Alderman Weinmann. Reading was approved on a voice vote.

Under New Business Mayor Shoffit discussed problems with Beaver Town Bridge. A list of phone numbers and email addresses for Arkansas Department of Transportation and Holiday Island Constable, Carroll County Judge, Sheriff, and Arkansas State Police. She encouraged council to get in touch with these different groups, identify themselves and report problems that are occurring on the bridge such as speeding, not stopping at stop signs, and overweight vehicles going across bridge.

Several ideas were discussed to help with parking situation at Beaver Town Park.

Alderwoman Lester moved to adjourn meeting, Alderman Weinmann seconded. Motion was approved by a voice vote.
